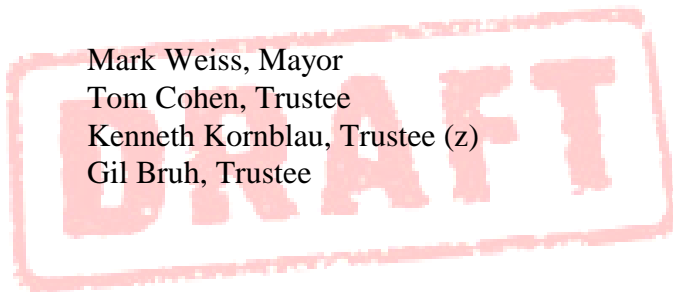
Minutes of the regular meeting of the

Public Comment:

Acceptance of the Minutes of the BOT September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, meeting: Motion made by Trustee Cohen to approve minutes. Seconded by Trustee Bruh. Unanimously approved 4-0.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Mazo read the September 2022 report.

Police and Security Reports for the month of September 2022 was reported by Police Commissioner/Trustee Tom Cohen. Trustee Cohen spoke about the recent car larcenies and the police enforcement on groups of children entering the Village on bicycles.

Hewlett Bay Fire Department Report for the month of September 2022 was reported by Fire Commissioner Tariq Khan.

Committee Reports:

- Public Works Report: VC Ryder reported about the Schenck Circle Road restoration project. We will be going to bid on Tuesday, October 25<sup>th</sup> at 11AM.
- Willow Pond Update: Mayor Weiss reported that there is no update on the pond. Everything looks great and no treatments were needed.

Building Department Updates: VC Ryder reported that there was a total of 11 (eleven) building and plumbing permits filed since the last Board of Trustees meeting on September 8, 2022. There were also 31 (thirty-one) inspections for the month of September.

Complaint Report: VC Ryder reported 21 (twenty-one) complaints were filed in the last month.

Old Business: VC Ryder reported that our shared service trial with Lynbrook went well and that we are going to continue to use their street sweeping service. We will schedule one last street sweeping before the winter season.

New Business: VC Ryder spoke about our recent D.O.T. bridge report. The bridge passed in all categories. D.O.T. recommends painting the underside of the bridge

A motion was made by Trustee Cohen to go into Executive Session at 8:34 P.M. seconded by Trustee Kornblau. Unanimously approved 4-0
