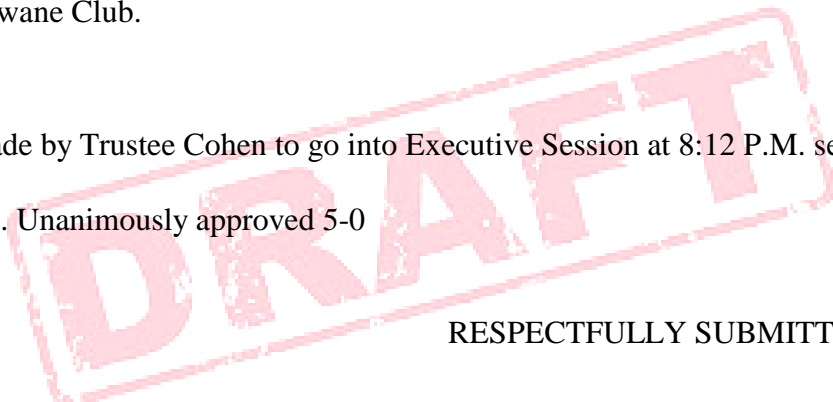
Complaint Report: Trustee Cohen reported 8 (eight) complaints were filed in the last month.
