- Willow Pond Update: VC Ryder informed us that Dr. Ron Abrams has submitted his proposal for the DEC permit application.
- Street Opening: Trustee Cohen stated nothing new to report for the month of February.

Building Department Updates: VC Ryder reported that there was a total of 9 (nine) building permits and 1 (one) plumbing permit filed since the last Board of Trustees meeting on February 9, 2023. There were also 20 (twenty) inspections for the month of February.

Complaint Report: VC Ryder reported 8 (eight) complaints were filed in the last month.
